What's Happening?

What: West Northamptonshire Council, in partnership with Kier Infrastructure, will be carrying out parapet rendering works to the internal sections of the structure. This work will also include pothole repairs.

Where: Kislingbury Bridge on High Street and the corner of Beech Lane

When: Monday 17 August – Friday 28 August

Working hours: 08.00 – 16.00 (24/7 road closure)

Traffic Management: There will be a full road closure in place during the works

Residents/Businesses: Due to the restricted width of the carriageway, which is just over 3 metres wide, it will not be possible to maintain access to all residential and business properties during the works. The limited available space, combined with the presence of construction materials, plant, and workforce activities, means that safe access cannot be achieved while work is underway.

Emergency Vehicles: Access will be permitted for emergency vehicles when safe to do so.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: Cyclists will be asked to follow the traffic management diversion route.

Public Transport: Public Transport will be affected by these works. Please consult with the relevant bus operator.

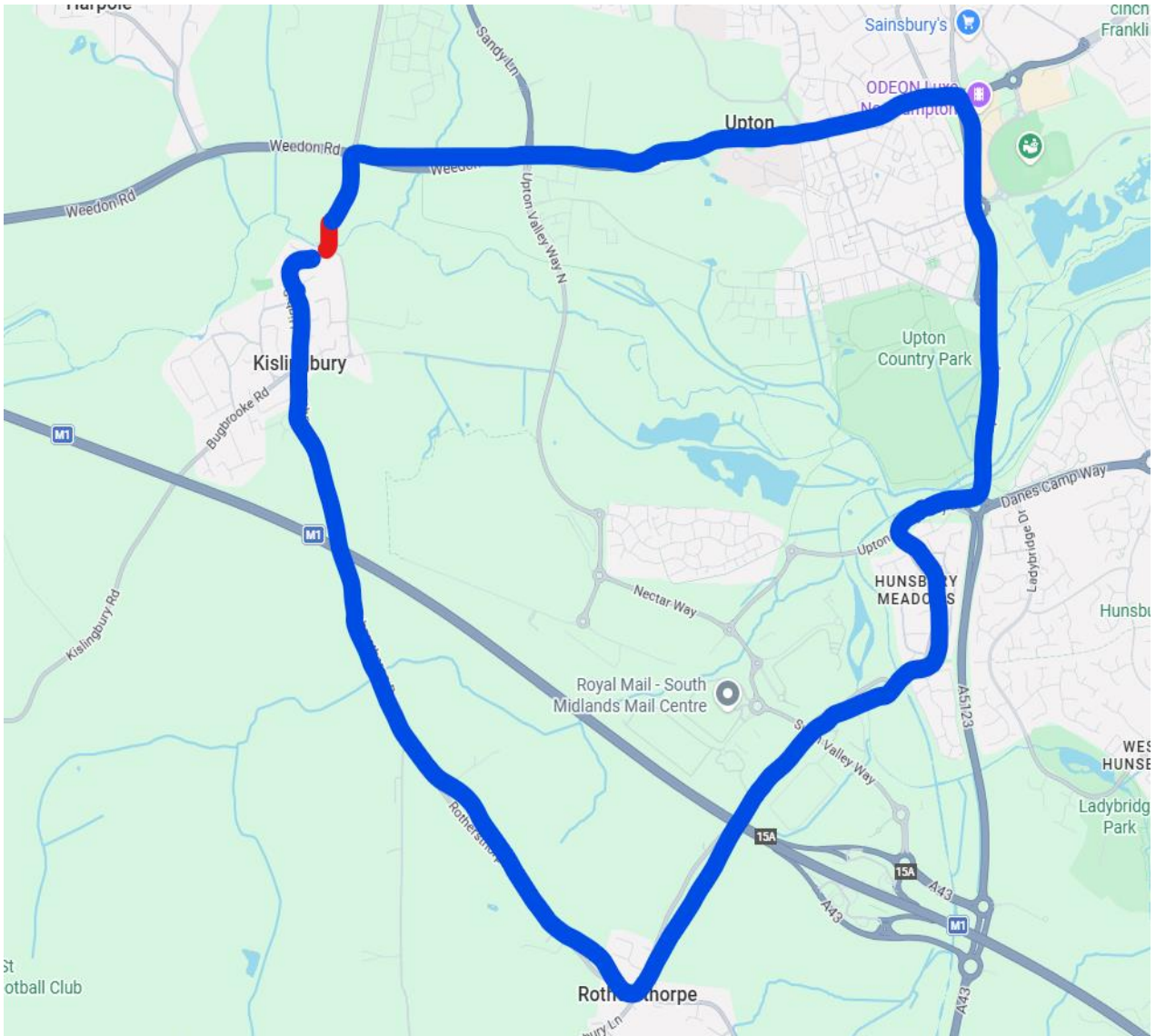
